# SPAY/NEUTER INFORMATION...

Pet overpopulation can be managed in a non-lethal manner through targeted, affordable spay and neuter programs. By contracting with local veterinarians, Pet Allies, Inc. provides top quality, high volume spay/neuter services for approximately 70 pets per month. Clients who meet financial guidelines pay a reduced fee. The balance of the cost for spay/neuter services is subsidized by Pet Allies, Inc. through fund-raising programs.

Visit the Barkin' Basement Thrift Store to pre-pay for a coupon and schedule your pet's appointment. Income qualifications must be met for this subsidized pricing. All clinic scheduling is done through the Barkin' Basement Thrift Store located at 4050 S. White Mountain Rd. in Show Low. Store hours are Tuesday through Saturday, 10:00 am to 4:00 pm, subject to change due to seasonal weather conditions. Please call (928) 532-1602 to verify hours of operation and availability of appointments. Appointments are on a first come, first serve basis, and can be 30-60 days from the date the appointment is made due to high demand for services. ## Don't Be a Litter Bug!

Pet Allies, Inc. offers assistance with free roaming cats. Programs are for "TNR" (Trap-Neuter-Return). Financial aid is offered to spay/neuter the cats. Humane traps and assistance with their use are available, as is advice on maintaining the colony. ## ADOPTION INFO...

Pet Allies averages 200 pets per year in foster care. Prior to adoption, they are given complete medical exams plus they are spayed or neutered, vaccinated and micro-chipped. The focus of the foster care program is to give each pet loving care and to find the home which best suits both the adopter and the pet.

Volunteer to change a life: provide a foster home, participate in adoption events, transport pets to veterinarian appointments, etc.
