

**Shelter Update:**

We needed help and so many of you responded! It's impossible to put into words what that means to us and the animals we lovingly care for.

It's that time of year when the Show Low Police Animal Control staff is overwhelmed with stray dogs and abandoned pet calls, which in turn impacts our little shelter. It's kitten season and we currently have 11 kittens in the Cat Suite and another 11 who are currently with our kitten fosters – we know there could be more. We have a tiny puppy with mange who's currently under treatment. Among others, Animal Control has brought us two malnourished stray dogs, and three cats abandoned in an apartment.

Your generosity not only helps us financially but also reaffirms that you care as much as we do about the animals that come through our doors. More times that we can count, we must call on our happy stories to get us through the difficult ones. But your support helps us do just that.

Thanks to you, we were able to secure much needed medical and foster supplies, make ends meet, and ensure our ability to offer the best care possible to our shelter animals. Sheltering agreement negotiations with the City have gone well, but we still need to ensure that we can cover 70% of all our operating costs.
